

## Sunday Service Guidance in light of Covid-19

### Please do not join us physically if...

- You or someone in your household has Covid-19 symptoms i.e. a new continuous cough, a high temperature, or a loss of / change in sense of taste / smell.
- The Government has advised you to quarantine due to foreign travel or track and trace.

### To bring with you

- A face covering which should be worn when inside unless eating/drinking, or speaking in the main meeting.
- You may like to bring your own Bible, pen, tissues, and any toys for your children.

### Tier 2 / 3 / 4 Covid Alert Levels

- All attendees should stay with their household and not interact with other attendees while they are inside St Nick's, unless taking part in a formal support group.
- Those exempt are staff, those on any rota (for the duration of their duty), and children while in church groups.

### Arrivals

- We encourage staggered arrivals from 10.30am.
- Please make use of hand sanitizer and handwashing facilities.
- Please keep at least 1m from all outside your household throughout. If necessary, please form a distanced queue when entering, or waiting e.g. for the toilets.
- Please take a seat as soon as possible as you enter.
- Please wait to be served any refreshments once you are seated.

### The Main Meeting

- Please ensure there is an empty chair between yourself and anyone not in your household.
- Handouts will include the Bible passage - please take away or discard these yourself.
- Communal singing may be paused or mitigated against as deemed appropriate.

### Children's Work

- Please read our 'Children's Work Procedures' page. Consent must be given for children to attend our groups because parents / guardians remain responsible for their children in relation to Covid-19 guidelines.

### Afterwards

- Unfortunately during Tier 2 / 3 / 4 restrictions, we are not able to host our regular weekly lunch together inside the building.
- Please head off promptly at the end of our formal time together.

### If you are 'clinically vulnerable' or would like to maintain more distance...

- Please be in touch as we would love to try and accommodate you e.g. with seating further apart, or a designated room upstairs. However, please be advised of the risks of attending.

### If someone starts displaying Covid-19 symptoms whilst at St Nick's...

- They must go home immediately without touching anyone / anything.
- Others who came into contact with them should wash their hands thoroughly, but are not required to leave unless they also develop symptoms or are told to quarantine by the Government.

This guidance is based on a risk assessment, intended to enable social distancing and hygiene to be maintained, having reflected on the latest guidance from the Government and Church of England.
