Introduction: What does trusting God in Babylon look like?

1. Babylon's power & wisdom (2v1-13)

- Fear of the unknown
- Inability to find answers
- Threat of violence

Conclusion: limited / tyrannical

2. In Babylon God's people should:

- i) Remain level headed (v14-16)
- ii) Gather trusted friends and pray (v17-19)

3. God: power & wisdom (2v20-23)

Conclusion: complete / trustworthy

Questions: Why are we sometimes too optimistic about 'Babylon'? How does this passage encourage us to put our trust in God? How should we do that?
