Introduction: Imagine if we could see the future!

1. **God alone is able to reveal the future (v24-30)**
2. **He shows us the future of earthly kingdoms (v31-43)**
 - Human influence is given by God (v37-38)
 - Human influence is taken by God (v40-43)
3. **He shows us the future of His kingdom (v44-45)**
 - never destroyed (v44a)
 - never taken away (v44b)
 - only future reality (v44c)
 - stand forever (v44d)

Conclusions:

Questions: God has shown us the future of human kingdoms: how should that change our thinking and actions? God has shown us the reality of his eternal kingdom: what should that do to us?
