Introduction: sin or suffer?

1. Prepared to suffer rather than sin (v16-18)
 - Defiance
 - Remain respectful
 - Right fear of the Lord (Luke 12:1-5; Acts 5:28ff)
2. The suffering looks especially nasty (v19-23)
 - Deeply personal
3. The Lord remained with them (v24-26)

Conclusion: The Lord will always deliver his people (v27-30):
