a. Jesus was conceived by the Holy Spirit

- God is faithful to His promises! cf. Isaiah 7:14
- Jesus is like no other king

b. He has come to save us from our sins

- Jesus = Greek form of Hebrew 'Joshua'i.e. 'the LORD saves'
- Sin is <u>persistent</u> *cf. Matthew 1:1-17*
- Sin has a <u>penalty</u>

 cf. Matthew 3:7, 13:42
