Introduction: why Jesus isn't too good to be true

a. He's a secure Son

"If you are the Son of God..." (v3, v6)

"Man shall not live by bread alone" (v4)

b. He's an obedient Son

"Again it is written, 'You shall not put the Lord your God to the test."" (v7)

c. He's a devoted Son

"You shall worship the Lord your God and <u>him only</u> shall you serve." (v10)

Conclusion: Jesus is different!
