Introduction: why Jesus isn't too good to be true

**a. He's a secure Son**

"If you are the Son of God..." (v3, v6)

"Man shall not live by bread alone" (v4)

**b. He's an obedient Son**

"Again it is written, 'You shall not put the Lord your God to the test.'" (v7)

**c. He's a devoted Son**

"You shall worship the Lord your God  
and him only shall you serve." (v10)

**Conclusion:** Jesus is different!
