Introduction: why Easter demands a response

a. Jesus deserves devotion

- *costly* devotion (v6-7)
- *shocking* devotion (v8-9)
- *beautiful* devotion (v10-13)

NOTE - Easter is more than a historical event!

b. Jesus' death *demand*s devotion

"After two days the Passover is coming, and the Son of Man will be delivered up to be crucified..." (v2)

"She has done it to prepare me for burial." (v12)

Conclusion: *Were the whole realm of nature mine
That were an offering far too small*
