Introduction: what's so great about Jesus' salvation?

**a. It's a destructive salvation**

- no more demons (v34)
- no more harm (v35)
- no more warnings (v36)

Demons are spirits (v33)  
committed to doing evil

- they harm people physically (8:2)
- they harm people mentally (8:35)
- they ultimately serve Satan (11:15)

**b. It's an authoritative salvation**

- an authoritative *word* (v32, v36)
- from the Holy One of God (v34)

Conclusion: God's kingdom is coming and Jesus is God's king

Why can we trust the salvation Jesus has come to bring?

What does this passage teach us about its nature?
