**Jesus offers a necessary salvation**

- the world is full of sickness (v40)
  
- the world is full of evil (v41)

Question - if not Jesus... what is your solution?

**... through a message of salvation**

*"I must preach the good news of the kingdom of God... for I was sent for this purpose." (v43)*

*"Everyone who hears my words and does them... he is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock." (6:47-48)*

Conclusion: believe the good news
