Introduction: how can we claim Jesus' salvation?

Jesus offers a necessary salvation

- the world is full of sickness (v40)
- the world is full of evil (v41)

Question - if not Jesus... what is your solution?

... through a message of salvation

"I must preach the good news of the kingdom of God... for I was sent for this purpose." (v43)

"Everyone who hears my words and does them... he is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock." (6:47-48)
